

The intent of this scholarship is to provide financial support for students who demonstrate leadership on and off the field/court and have a passion for bringing out the best in themselves and others.

Scholarship Information

- The Joe Lockhart Family Scholarship will be awarded during the summer after high school graduation
- Provides one \$1000 scholarship annually for college expenses including tuition, books and fees

Criteria

- Students must apply in their senior year of high school
- Students must receive a College Preparatory diploma at graduation
- Top 10% of Senior Class **NOT** eligible
- Students must have a 2.5 minimum cumulative GPA at a time of high school graduation to receive the scholarship
- Students must have TWO recommendations letters
 - One from their coach
 - One from a CORE subject teacher substantiating the student's ability to be successful in college level coursework.
- Students must submit a one-page essay on how their participation in a particular sport shaped them for future success

The counseling office of the Sequatchie County High School will disseminate scholarship criteria, obtain completed applications and remit them to the Community Foundation. The Community Foundation for Northeast Georgia will establish a selection committee. All scholarship decisions will be made by the Community Foundation selection committee.

Recipients will request the scholarship funds from the **Northeast Georgia Community Foundation** by providing proof of registration at an accredited college or university. The scholarship money will be sent directly to the college or university of the recipient's choice. No money will ever be awarded directly to the recipient.

Two \$500 scholarships will be presented in honor of *Flavius Allen Barker* and in memory of Naomi Miller Barker by their family.

Flavius is a 1949 graduate of Sequatchie County High School. He was a dairy farmer and sold and repaired farm machinery for Barker's Garage. He was a member of the Administrative Board and the Board of Trustees at Chapel Hill United Methodist Church. He served as President of the Sequatchie County Farm Bureau for over 30 years, member of the Tennessee Farm Bureau Board of Directors for over 20 years, Vice-President of the TFBF and then Tennessee Farm Bureau President for 10 years. He was a member of the American Farm Bureau and the American Livestock Producers Boards of Directors. He also served on the Board and as Chairman of the Chattanooga area Production Credit/AgCredit Association. He has been on the State of Tennessee Board and the Atlanta District Federal Reserve Board. Except for the ten years as TFBF President, he is a lifelong resident of Sequatchie County. Flavius has always loved to tend to growing things, whether they be children or plants or animals.

Naomi was born the twelfth of thirteen children in Union County, Tennessee. The family moved to Loudon County in 1935 when the Norris Dam project took their farm. She was a graduate of Lenoir City High and the University of Tennessee. She came to Dunlap in 1949 to teach Home Economics at Sequatchie County High School, which she did for six years. She then became a full-time homemaker, mother, and farm wife. She served as the first President of the Griffith Elementary Parent Teachers Association and volunteered at church and in the community. At church, she was a Sunday school teacher and Treasurer of the Board of Trustees. She served as chairman of the county Farm Bureau Women for several years. After the children were older, she worked in the office at Barker Chevrolet. She enjoyed raising her family, traveling, and supporting Flavius on the farm an in his service and leadership roles.

Education was always important in the family. All but one of Naomi's adult siblings received a post-secondary diploma. Each of Barker's four children: Ann Hale, Charles Barker, Allen Barker, and Sarah Hampton are SCHS alumni and university graduates.

These scholarships are open to Sequatchie County High School Seniors who are planning to further their education by attending any post-secondary program, professional or technical school. The scholarship payment will be made upon successfully completing the first semester at the school of choice.
