How much are tickets?

Tickets are \$40 each and are on sale until Friday, July 10, 2020, at 3:05.

What can I use as a form of payment?

You may use checks made out to SCHS with your name on the memo line, cash or money order. You can mail your check or money order to SCHS, Po Box 759, Dunlap TN 37327

When and where can I buy a prom ticket?

Tickets will be sold May 22 at SCHS during the scheduled times set forth by the Director of Schools. You may also purchase tickets via mail. You can mail your completed form(s) and check or money order to SCHS, Po Box 759, Dunlap TN 37327.

What is the “Prom Rules Form”?

SCHS requires **ALL students** to sign and complete a “Prom Rules Form” in order to get a prom ticket. The form *requires a parent signature* and outlines SOME of the basic rules about prom. These forms must be turned in to Amy Layne. These forms will be turned in on May 22 at SCHS or mailed to SCHS.

Where can I get a “Guest Application” or a “Prom Rules Form”?

All forms can be found on the Sequatchie County High School’s Web Page or at SCHS on May 22.

Can you explain date tickets?

Date tickets can be purchased by any JUNIOR or SENIOR enrolled at SCHS. There is an application that must be completed by each outside date (anyone who is NOT an SCHS student) in order to get a ticket. All dates must sign a “Prom Rules Form” also. Dates must be in at least the 9th grade and must be 20 years old or younger at the time of the prom. Date applications are due by July 10, 2020. **All guests must enter and leave with the person who purchased their prom ticket.**

What can I wear to prom?

Prom is a FORMAL event, so formal attire is required. No see-through clothing, lingerie/lingerie-style clothing, or revealing attire. No ball hats, shorts, jeans, or togas. No leggings. You will not be admitted to the prom nor will your tickets be refunded if you fail to follow the dress code. Dress code enforcement is at the discretion of the school administration.

How early do I need to get to prom?

You will NOT be allowed to enter the venue until **6:45 central standard time**.

What do I need to bring to prom?

All you need is your ticket. Outside guests must be prepared to show a photo ID at the door.

Once I get to prom, can I leave and come back?

NO. Once a student has entered prom, he/she will not be permitted to leave and come back.

What about pictures?

Photographers from LifeTouch will be present to take care of all of your formal picture needs. Packages will be ordered and paid for the night of prom and all checks for pictures needs to be made out to LifeTouch. Package brochures are available in the library, office and outside Amy Layne's door. Pictures will begin at 7:00 p.m.

When will Prom Court and King and Queen be announced?

The court will be announced and the crowning will take place at 8:30 p.m. CST.

Where is Stratton Hall?

Stratton Hall is located at 3146 Broad Street in Chattanooga, Tennessee. See the attached map for detailed instructions.

Where do I park?

There is a dedicated parking lot at Stratton Hall.

Is there anything else I need to know?

Student's and/or guests found in possession or under the influence of drugs and or alcohol are subject to severe disciplinary action, including a call to the parents for pick-up, suspension from school and arrest by Hamilton County law enforcement officers. This includes in any vehicles that are brought to the school's event location. Also, since prom is a school-sponsored event, all SCHS rules as outlined in the student handbook will apply. We do utilize a breathalyzer upon entrance to the prom.
